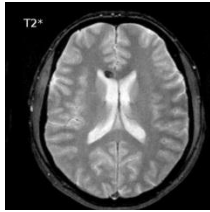

Dr Pat O'Neill

Dr Pat O'Neill is a Medical Consultant in Orthopaedic and Sports Medicine at the Mater Private Hospital and Cappagh National Orthopaedic Hospital in Dublin; and University Lecturer in Orthopaedic Sports Medicine at Trinity College Dublin.

He specialises in the diagnostic assessment, investigation and treatment of sports injuries, and occupational and general non-surgical orthopaedic and musculoskeletal injuries, conditions and disorders in collaboration with radiology, rheumatology, neurology, orthopaedic surgery and other medical and surgical specialists and consultants at the Mater Private Hospital and Cappagh National Orthopaedic Hospital
